



RV5000 RESTORING WOODS

Restoring heavily degraded woods

Fields of use: This product can be used for worn and degraded wood such as windows, doors, garden furniture, cladding, fences and beams.

Product information: RV5000 is a pigmented water primer that allows to renovate existing partially painted, degraded and wom down wooden products. The application process provides a coating with slightly coloured finishes and gives the product the appearance of wood it needs. The cream colour is similar to that of new wood that has been unpainted and is excellent for a starting point for any colour. RV5000 can be applied on darker woods or even old layers of existing varnishes. The primer provides the surface with high quality UV protection that differs itself from other wood primers.

Instructions for use:

If you are going to prime unpainted wood, you must then sand the wood with a grit between 180-220 grain, following the wood grain and not across. Clean up the area, free from dust before applying the application.

In the case of painted wood, sand thoroughly with sanding grits between 80-150. The old layers of paint should then start to fade, clean up the area before applying any sort of application.

Reapply coats after 4 hours, but no later than 16 hours apart.

Sizes: 0.75ml, 2.5L







Store above 5°C

Apply above 10°C





Ready to use

Brush and spray





Yeild 20 m2/l

Mix well before use



Reapply after 4 hours, and not over 16 hours.
